

# Nepal Earthquake Response: Jajarkot

## Situation Report #3

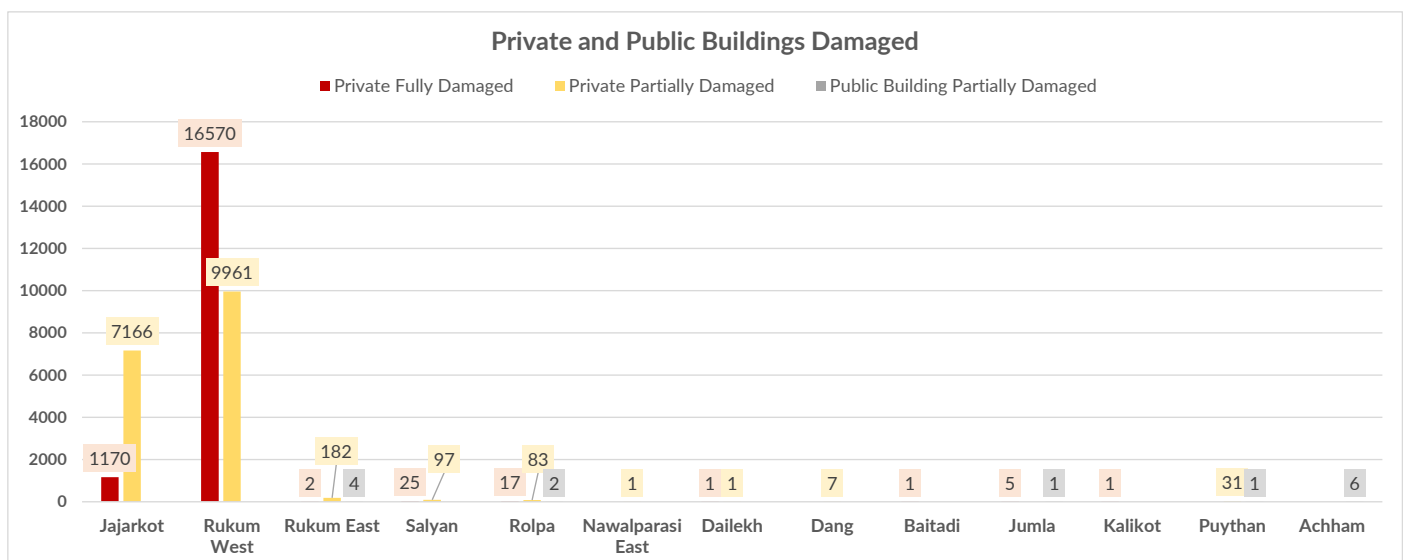
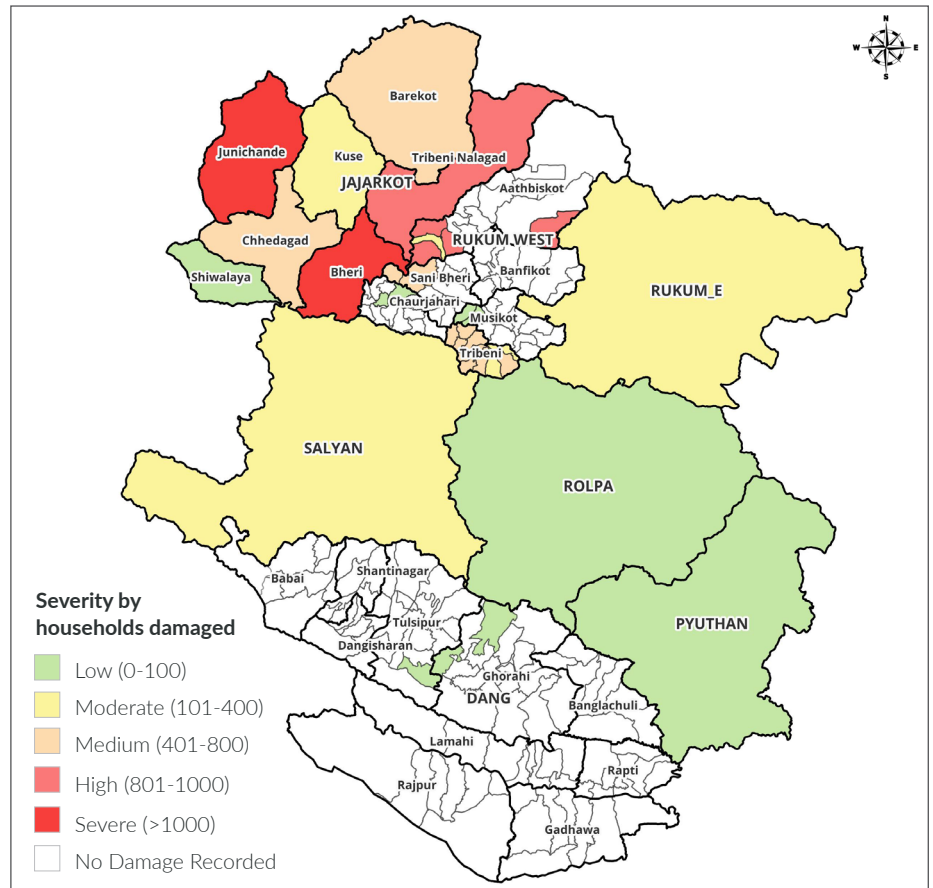

This report is produced by National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Authority (NDRRMA) in collaboration with partners. It covers the situation of Jajarkot, Rukum West and neighboring districts following the earthquake and subsequent aftershocks on 3 November 2023.

### Highlights

1. Rescue operations completed and Relief operations started.
2. High households damage recorded in Jajarkot and Rukum West.
3. Ward level household damage data is being collected in Jajarkot.
4. Armed Police Force Nepal has established **temporary accomodation centers** in Nalagadh and Bheri of Jajarkot.
5. **NPR. 2,45,99,65,000** worth of estimated private property loss in Rukum West (NPR. 2,45,95,00,000) and Dang (NPR. 4,65,000).
6. Various humanitarian organizations reacting to appeal and supporting in relief distribution.



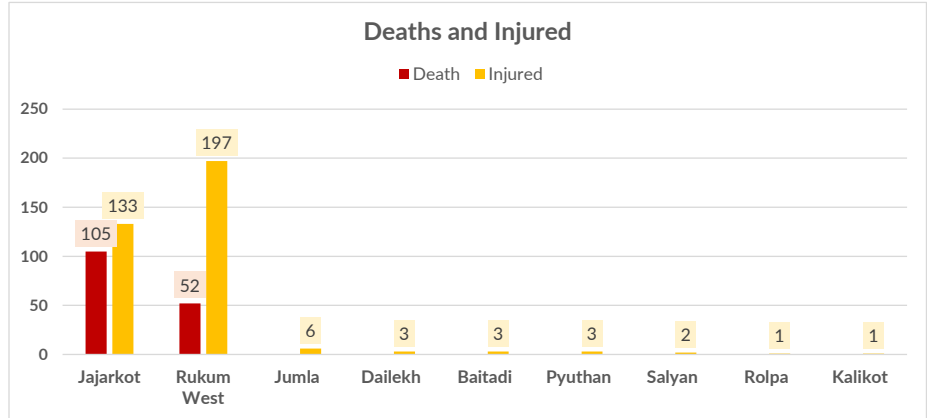

### Situation Overview

High number of private houses damages has been recorded in Jajarkot and Rukum West. In response to the earthquake impact, the Armed Police Force (APF) Nepal in Jajarkot has successfully set up temporary shelter camps across earthquake-affected areas, specifically in Nalagadh and Bheri Rural Municipalities. In Nalagadh, **3 temporary camps with 20 beds each has been set up**, while **in Bheri 5 camps with a combined capacity of 100 beds are now operational**. These temporary accomodation shelters have been established with the aim of providing temporary relief for earthquake-affected individuals for a projected duration of about 5-6 months. The camps are equipped with essential amenities, including electricity,

water, and toilet facilities, including water pumps. Additionally, the APF has plans to create similar facilities in two other locations based on local needs and demands.

Till the reporting hour **157 deaths** and **349 injured** have been registered. Relief distribution in Jajarkot and Rukum West has started in a one door relief distribution system.

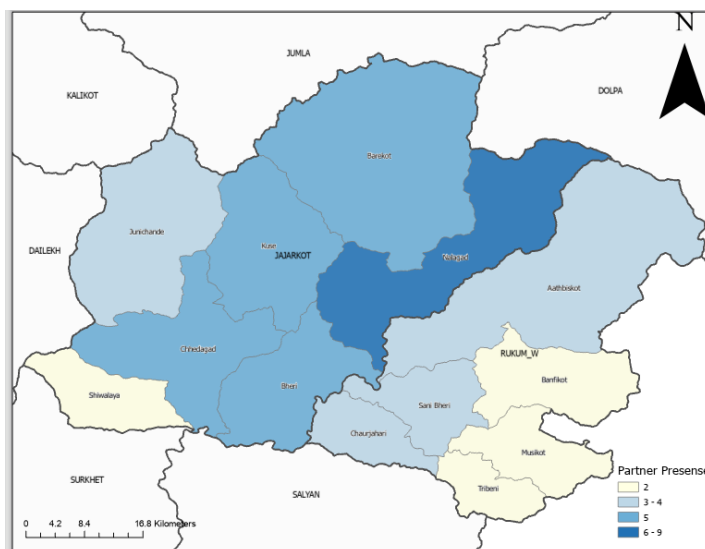
